Congress had made it official with the Neutrality Act, and Germans were the first or second largest ancestral group in the US. FDR also knew that it was inevitable that the US would have to go to war against Germany, so he and Churchill designed the "Lend Lease" program in March 1941 in order to get war materials and food to the allies. He still had the problem of getting the population for going to war, but the Japanese took care of that by bombing Pearl Harbor on December 7, 1941.

I was six years old, and I still remember the headline in the Knoxville News Sentinel. It was completely politically incorrect, and it would be banned today: JAPS BOMB PEARL HARBOR. We did to Germany and Japan what General Sherman did to Georgia in the Civil War. He didn't worry about collateral damage. Sherman made sure my ancestors would not fight again.

In spite of Obama's "apology tour," the US has done more good for the world than any other country in modern history. At the end of WW II our enemies lay in shambles.
